GRADES: 6th grade & up (including adults)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this class students will learn traditional techniques and methods of oil painting and then develop their personal style and process. Class subjects will be on color theory, light logic, perspective, composition, mark-making, and more. Throughout the year, students will paint from Old Master artworks, plaster casts, still lifes, plants/trees, live-portrait models, and photographs. Students will also work on personal painting projects with their own intent or goals for their art. This is a really informative and fun art class for beginners and advanced artists alike to develop as an artist and progress in their skills and creativity.
